Efforts of the New Jersey Aviation Association Result in Release of the State's 2008 Spending Plan

Justin Edwards, NJAA Board Chairman announced, today, that the New Jersey Department of Transportation's Office of Aeronautics (NJDOT) has released its FY 2008 Spending Plan which provides grants from a dedicated trust fund to airports for the completion of safety and security projects.

Chairman Edwards credits the spending plan's approval to the persistence of NJAA's members working with the NJDOT officials to ensure that projects could be completed during the summer construction season.

Arlene Feldman, NJAA's president points out that "this is yet another example of the tremendous positive contributions that NJAA is making to the New Jersey Aviation System."
